




## **CONTENT:**

Introduced in 1985, as a successor to the Giulietta models this particular model line is celebrating its 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary, coinciding with Alfa's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary and commemorated by the brand in the very same year. Against the background of Alfa Romeo's acquisition by Fiat in 1986, these middle class saloon cars represented in many enthusiasts' eyes the last real Alfas, with both their characteristic features of transaxle technique and rear-wheel drive.

This new book depicts the complete development history of these popular young classics, including a comprehensive account of their racing activities and successes. It provides an overview on their production volume, their chassis numbers and further technical specifications, containing a wealth of previously unpublished beautiful photographs, along with contemporary promotional material.

The author, Umberto di Paolo, is an acknowledged expert on Alfa cars who has already published five titles on this subject – covering Alfa Romeo 75 there is hardly another book available with a comparable extend and endowment.
