CONTENT:

These typical Mercedes vehicles which had shaped the 1950's street scene as a popular taxi vehicle, have all but disappeared nowadays. Many of them have always been unaffordable for average wage earners, but some models, especially those equipped with four-cylinder engines, were not that popular at the time and were sold at comparatively low prices during their second life as used cars.

This new buyer's guide provides a wealth of information on all questions that may arise when considering the purchase of a four- or six-cylinder Mercedes-Benz Ponton model built between 1953 and 1962, covering types W 120, W 121, W 105, W 180 and W 128. Numerous checklists referring to all assembly groups will help the reader to evaluate any vehicles on offer.
