LOST IN TANGO

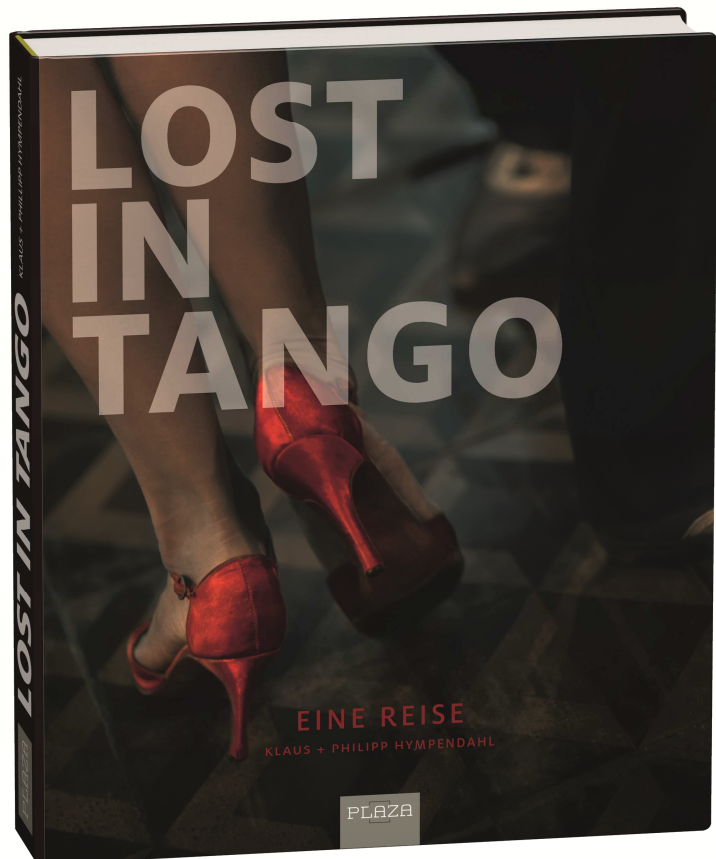
