Besides chess pieces coming to life, there is a smart little goblin who guides the children through the scene, explains the figurines' respective roles on the chess board and within the game, and answers all kinds of questions.

Next to basic terms and rules, thus explained in a child-friendly way, young readers also get introduced into the art of setting traps, special openings, as well as tactics and strategies during the course of the game.
