The author Schuh-Bertl has been running his shoemaker's shop in Munich for over 25 years, which he took over in 1989. In the beginning, only a few pairs and mostly custom-made shoes went over the counter, but today he can no longer cope with the large demand from all over the world on his own and employs around 40 craftsmen.
